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NCOPE Is Pleased to Introduce NCOPE Tracker

ALEXANDRIA, VA – On July 1, 2018, The National Commission on Orthotic and Prosthetic Education (NCOPE) will launch its new online clinical experience tracking system for resident practitioners and mentors, ***NCOPE Tracker***. NCOPE Tracker will replace the Typhon Group Allied Health Tracking System (AHTS), currently being used to track residency program training. NCOPE Tracker was designed from the ground up with the O&P profession in mind and is structured to better align with the needs of residents and mentors.

NCOPE Tracker has many enhancements over the Typhon AHTS for residents, mentors and administrators including:

- Support for desktop, laptop and mobile platforms including tablets and smartphones.
- Enhanced reporting tools to better inform residents and mentors about the experiences the resident is receiving.
- The ability to input data exported from EMR systems.

Residents that begin their residency between March 1, 2018 and July 1, 2018 will be required to log patient interactions using an NCOPE provided spreadsheet until NCOPE Tracker is officially released.

NCOPE and the NCOPE Tracker development team would like to thank the many residents, mentors, directors and beta-testers for their input on NCOPE Tracker. We sincerely feel that NCOPE Tracker will provide residency programs with the data and resources necessary to delivery the best possible training opportunity for resident practitioners.

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
