 - Part-time → Less than 37.5 hours per week

 - Resuming a residency after COVID-19



Impact on Current NCOPE Resident Documentation





Pending Submission Status means -

- Incomplete Residency
- Missing Transcripts

Pending Submission Status



- Incomplete Residency
 - Unable to complete your residency by the deadline?
 - Contact us immediately!
 - Your residency must be complete for exam eligibility.

No exceptions can be made.

Impact on Current ABC Applicants

Pending Status



- Missing Transcripts
 - Unable to provide an official transcript? We will accept a formal letter of graduation from your Registrar's office until an official transcript can be provided.
 - The letter must indicate your conferral date.
 - We must have your official transcript before you sit for your exam.
